Originally from Fisher River Cree Nation, Brandon reached out to the Foundation expressing his interest in participating on the Board. In his e-mail he wrote: “I work as a support worker at CEDA Pathways and I am involved in my union. My role is to engage more young and indigenous workers to join the labour movement. This will be another great opportunity to learn from other people on the subcommittee and share my union volunteer experiences to try engage more model school alumni's.” The program that he works for supports 375 students a year in Winnipeg, helping them graduate from high school and transition to post-secondary education, training or employment. According to the Winnipeg Free Press, the rate of graduation in the North End is 55%, meanwhile in suburban Winnipeg it is 98%. After the Collegiate, Brandon went on to study Urban and inner-city studies.
