

# 2021-22 President's Scholarship for World Leaders

These scholarships will be given to international students who are entering any of the University's divisions for the first time – Undergraduate, Graduate, Collegiate, Professional, Applied and Continuing Education (PACE) or English Language Program (ELP). Applicants must be involved in activities that demonstrate leadership.

## Eligibility: Candidates must meet the following criteria:

- Have a minimum 80% admission average or equivalent
- Be an international student
- Entering first year of any program/school
- Demonstrate exceptional leadership qualities
- Submit a complete application for admission by the scholarship deadline
